AWAI - Place and Time

My works are recollections of my passages, which capture impressive encounters of the surroundings – trees, flowering plants or urban/rural landscapes - appealing to me at the right place and moment.

"Awai", an ancient word of "Ma" in Japanese, has multiple meanings including timing, distance, space and balance. When it comes together I get the cue to press the shutter. Those photographic images are my drawing materials to unveil precious reminiscences.

Touch of Light

Light and shadow reveal the form of the structure. They add another layer of dimension and lyricism to the materials, which further accentuate the skin of the building.

Travertine, concrete, metal and glass - selected materials complementing each other in tone and surfaces- achieve a sense of serenity and elegance. Simple and unadorned each of these materials shows its innate character through its variation of texture.

Since natural light in itself is always changing I strive to capture the moments where light and architecture intersect - adding yet another dimension to the composition. With using photography as my medium I both discover and express the purities of form, texture and function in a minimalistic manner. Such experiences are my treasure - however brief - as another encounter with time.
