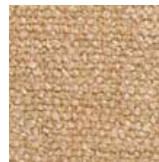

## CLEANING & CARE

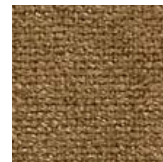
- Professional dry cleaning with any solvent except trichloroethylene is recommended.
- For optimal textile performance, maintain fabrics by gently vacuuming dirt before it becomes embedded, wipe or blot spills as soon as they occur, and spot clean soon after stains occur. When spot cleaning, always test a small, inconspicuous part of the furniture in case of discoloration or shrinkage. Avoid excessive brushing that may abrade the fibers.
- Due to the viscose content, shadowing can occur after normal use when exposed to pressure, heat or humidity.

*(cleaning and care, continued...)*

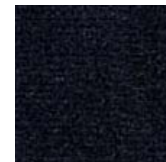
This causes the pile to flatten and reflect light differently. A light steaming can increase the flexibility of the yarns and make them malleable. After steaming, brush the surface to bring the pile back to its original direction. Be careful not to soak the surface of the fabric with the humidity, as viscose requires only a light amount of steam to train the pile back to its upright position.

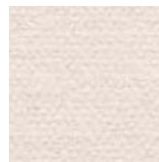
