DESCRIPTION

Designed by Christian Astuguevieille, Bayonne is a casual washed linen with a rare 54" wide repeat. The heavy weight linen ground has a woven backing and is embroidered and produced in Italy. This pattern was inspired by Astuguevieille's love for ethnic materials and vessels. Bayonne is named after the town in the South of France Coast where Astuguevieille summers.

CLEANING & CARE

- Professional dry cleaning with any solvent except trichloroethylene is recommended.
- For optimal textile performance, maintain fabrics by gently vacuuming dirt before it becomes embedded, wipe or blot spills as soon as they occur, and spot clean soon after stains occur. When spot cleaning, always test a small, inconspicuous part of the furniture in case of discoloration or shrinkage. Avoid excessive brushing that may abrade the fibers.
