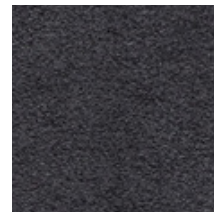

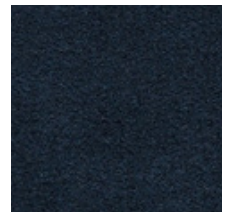

MAINTENANCE

- Wipe or blot spills as soon as they occur and spot clean soon after stains occur. When spot cleaning, always test a small, inconspicuous part of the furniture in case of discoloration or shrinkage. Avoid excessive brushing that may abrade the fibers.
- For periodic cleaning, dust the material using a soft brush, dry cloth, or a vacuum then moisten a soft cloth or a sponge in clean water. Wring the cloth or sponge thoroughly and glide it over the material. Do not dampen excessively. Rinse the cloth or sponge and repeat as necessary. Leave to dry overnight. Once dried, restore the material by gently brushing the nap.
- Gentle, professional dry cleaning with any solvent except trichloroethylene is recommended for overall cleaning.

MACHINE WASHING

When necessary, Italian Alcantara can be machine washed by carefully following the below instructions.

- Removable upholstery can be safely machine washed with water at about 85° F (30° C) and a mild detergent. Do not spin-dry. Velcro fastenings must be protected with a counter-Velcro piece before washing to protect the upholstery. Once the upholstery is washed, let it air dry and brush it delicately with a soft bristle brush. Italian Alcantara is not to be bleached with chlorine.

IRONING

– Italian Alcantara can be ironed, making sure that a white cloth barrier is placed between the iron and the product. The base of the iron must not reach a temperature higher than 110°C. Gentle steam is allowed only at a low temperature.

GENERAL SPOT CLEANING

In the case of localized stains, the textile can be cleaned as follows:

- Act soon after stain occurs. Be sure to remove any excess substance with a spoon or absorbent cloth or sponge before treating. Stains should be treated from the outside edge into the center in order to avoid the stain spreading. Avoid excessive rubbing.
- Do not pour cleaning products directly onto material.
- Always use a clean white cloth or sponge and rinse in clean water between wiping.

WATER-SOLUBLE STAINS

- FOOD STAINS: Use lukewarm water and rinse by dabbing with clean water.
- BLOOD: Use COLD water. Rinse by dabbing with clean water.
- ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES & SOFT DRINKS: Use lukewarm water, if the color mark remains, treat it with lemon juice and rinse well.

– VINEGAR & COFFEE: Use lemon juice and wipe with lukewarm water. Rinse by dabbing with clean water.

STAINS NOT SOLUBLE IN WATER

- OIL, INK, GREASE & COSMETICS: Rub with ethyl alcohol, then with water and rinse.
- CHEWING GUM: Harden the gum by cooling it with ice cubes in a plastic bag. Carefully remove the chewing gum from the material and treat with ethyl alcohol.
